Habitat for Humanity of Greene County is a chapter of Habitat for Humanity of Greater Charlottesville. Our mission is to bring people together to build and rebuild homes and communities while catalyzing new pathways to safe, decent, affordable housing.

The Greene County Habitat Home Repair Program offers repairs to low-wealth local homeowners to make their houses accessible, livable, and safe.

Repairs that can be addressed through the Greene County Habitat Home Repair Program:

- Accessibility modifications (wheelchair ramp, etc.)
- Exterior Carpentry Repairs
- Exterior Painting
- Exterior Doors and Windows
- Exterior Cleaning (trash removal, landscaping)

Repairs we currently do not address through the Program:

- Interior repair needs
- Mobile home repair needs
- Mold, asbestos, or lead paint remediation

Eligibility Requirements include:

- Must own your home, unless applying for ramp
- If applying for a ramp, must have permission from landlord
- Household income must be below 80% AMI*
- Commitment to owning your home for at least the next three years
- Willingness to perform sweat equity on the Project based on your physical ability
- General willingness to partner
- Able to provide a safe working environment for volunteers

Projects will be selected based on need and how well the scope of work aligns with available funding.
